The patient treatment goals of wellness include: restore the function of body region affected by chronic pain; regain the physical strength, endurance, and fitness to return to normal life activities; learn how to relieve emotional distress related to pain through mind-body awareness and positive health attitudes; educate and inform parents how to support and respond to their child in ways that promote wellness, positive coping with pain and stress. Parents are expected to participate in the program daily and attend parent education weekly."
